1 written eviction notice



a written notice is required to begin the eviction process.

2 eviction case filed



After the notice expires, the landlord must file a complaint at the courthouse in the county where you live to start your court case.

service of court summons

sheriff enforces eviction order



finally, the sheriff will have to enforce the eviction order and remove the tenant from the

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eviction court hearing



You must appear in court on that date, or the court could decide against you.

If the landlord wins, the court will grant an "order of possession" (eviction order) against the tenant.

after case is filed,
the sheriff (or a
private process
server) attempts to
serve tenants a copy
of the complaint and a
summons to appear in
court.
